# Theory MUST be completed with sufficient Experience







#### Approaches to Certification Generally

Fast Track – Provides a concise and clear path to certification whereby the applicant has graduated from an IBSC recognized Category A or Category B educational program.

<u>Medium Track</u> – Provides a more complex approach to certification. The applicant has graduated with a BSc in Geospatial Sciences (or equivalent) and has taken additional focused hydrographic surveying subjects.

<u>Slow Track</u> – Provides a complicated, but achievable, approach to certification. The applicant has graduated from a technical college or similar. In this situation, the applicant is required to show proof of significant additional geospatial and hydrographic learning.


