Since 1985, the German Hydrographic Society (Deutsche Hydrographische Gesellschaft – DHyG) has published its own hydrographic journal. Today, *Hydrographische Nachrichten* is the only journal for hydrography and geoinformation in German-speaking countries. Every year, three issues are printed with articles in German and English language.

In *Hydrographische Nachrichten*, scientific articles as well as reports on practical experiences and relevant projects are published. There are also articles about new technical developments, applications and events. Moreover, each issue features a multi-page interview with a leading person from the field of hydrography.

Especially marked scientific articles have undergone a peer review according to international standards.

The printed journal has a circulation of 750 copies and is sent to all members and some libraries also. Furthermore, the journal is distributed at various professional events such as the »Hydrographentage« and Hydro conferences.

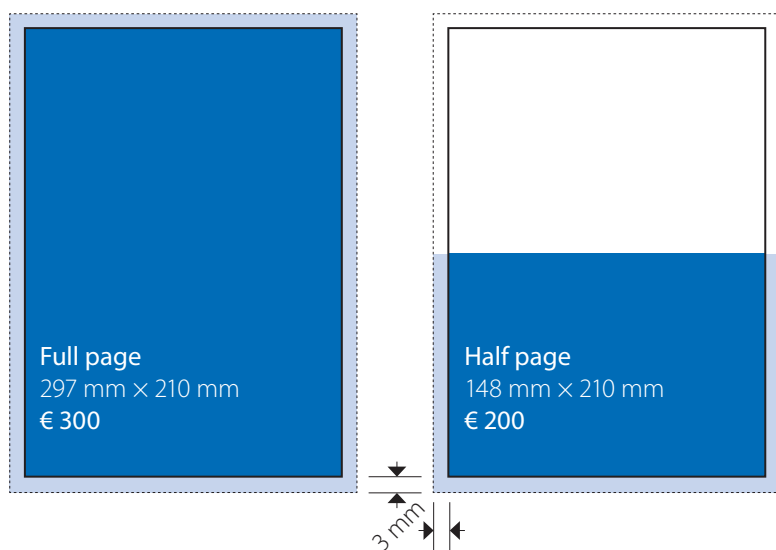

# Information for contributors

Share your knowledge by publishing an article in *Hydrographische Nachrichten*. Your article will reach an interested, enthusiastic readership and a group of highly specialised experts.

The submitted paper must not have been published in this form to date. Please include a summary of 100 to 200 words at the beginning of your manuscript and a list of at least five key words.

Please submit your text as a MS Word file and additionally as a PDF file.

Make sure that hyphenation is switched off in the Word file and that you have not inserted any manual hyphenations.

The length of the text should not exceed 4500 words (plus references).

A text submitted for peer review must be at least 3000 words long and written in British English.

Please also send integrated images as separate files with a resolution of at least 300 dpi.

By submitting the manuscript, you agree that the text may be edited without altering its meaning. Decisions regarding paper acceptance and publication time are made by the editorial team.

### Text

Text as a MS Word file,  
automatic hyphenation must be deactivated,  
without manual hyphenation

### Figures and images

Separate files with a resolution of at least 300 dpi,  
with captions

### Bibliographic references

American citation (e.g., Mueller 2012),  
indication of first name and surname

### Editorial deadline

June issue (HN 128): May 15th

November issue (HN 129): September 15th
